WORKSHOPS

Habitat Studies

Leaving Cert Ecology – A Scientific Study of an Ecosystem (Seashore/Grassland/Woodland)
- Emphasis is placed on the techniques of fieldwork and the recording and analysis of abiotic, biotic and climatic factors, organism distribution and adaptations of flora and fauna.

Junior Cert Ecology – Local Habitat Study (Seashore/Grassland/Woodland)

- Using appropriate instruments and simple keys to show the variety and distribution of plant and animal life. Study of food webs, adaptations competition and interdependence.

Other Workshops

Marine Litter Workshop

Marine Litter and the ocean. Includes looking at common everyday items that impact on our ocean and the choices we make; how long materials take to break down; and games to emphasise the effect of good and bad environmental choices. Can include a beach clean and data analysis.

Sustainability workshop

The cod story: a workshop on Marine Biodiversity and food production. Involves News Mapping and meeting the characters of the story in the aquarium

Engineering Workshop

Flood Defences: a workshop on people & the coastal environment including elements of marine engineering and maths

Maths Workshop

Design your own exhibit: A creative workshop using maths whilst engaging in environmental awareness and care and learning about animal husbandry

Animal Anatomy Workshop

Students are introduced to marine biodiversity and different types of body structure, and adaptations. They complete a squid dissection in small groups.
